The Fourth International Conference on the History of Mathematics Education was hosted by Academy of Sciences and

University of Turin (Italy). About 50 senior and junior researchers from 16 countries met for four days to talk about one topic: the history of mathematics education. In total 44 contributions were presented. The themes were Ideas, people and movements, Transmission of ideas, Teacher education, Geometry and textbooks, Textbooks - changes and origins, Curriculum and reform, Teaching in special institutions, and Teaching of geometry.
