Leibniz was probably the last universal scholar in modern times who made original and innovative achievements in all the essential fields of knowledge of his time: as a reform-oriented lawyer, a multilateral thinking diplomat, as a mathematician of infinitesimal calculus, as the inventor of a calculating machine and in the mining of horizontal wind power, as an organizer of science and as one of the first historians who strived for source-critical methodical objectivity. However, this baroque diversity

can only be understood from the center of a monadological philosophy, which wants to establish the unity of scientific worldview and metaphysical concept of the world. It is distorted in the classical reception because only Leibniz the Theodicy was known. The topicality of Leibniz today consists in re-exposing the original basic idea of unity in diversity and asking how it can be made fruitful for philosophical and political thought in the 21st century. This book is a translation of the original German 1st edition Leibniz und die Folgen by Jörg Zimmer, published by J.B. Metzler, imprint of Springer-Verlag GmbH, part of Springer Nature in 2018. The translation was done with the help of artificial intelligence (machine translation by the service DeepL.com). A subsequent human revision was done primarily in terms of content, so that the book will read stylistically differently from a conventional translation. Springer Nature works continuously to further the development of tools for the production of books and on the related technologies to support the authors.

The aim of this volume is to investigate three fundamental issues of the new millennium: language, truth and democracy. The

authors approach the themes from different philosophical perspectives. One group of authors examines the use of language and the meaning of concepts from an analytic point of view, the ontology of scientific terms and explores the nature of knowledge in general. Another group examines truth and types of relation. A third group of authors focuses on the current factors influencing our concept of democracy and its legal foundations and makes reference to moral aspects and the question of political responsibility. The chapters provide the reader with an overview of current philosophical problems and the answers to these questions will be decisive for future development.

This volume explores in detail Kierkegaard's various relations to his German contemporaries. Kierkegaard read German fluently and made extensive use of the writings of German-speaking authors. Apart from his contemporary Danish sources, the German sources were probably the most important in the development of his thought generally. This volume represents source-work research dedicated to tracing Kierkegaard's readings and use of the various German-speaking authors in the different fields in a way that is as clearly documented as possible. The volume has been divided into three tomes reflecting Kierkegaard's main areas of interest with regard to the German-speaking sources, namely, philosophy, theology and a more loosely conceived category, which has here been designated "literature and aesthetics." This first tome treats the German philosophical influences on Kierkegaard. The dependence of Danish philosophy on German philosophy is beyond question. In a book review in his Hegelian journal *Perseus*, the poet, playwright and critic, Johan Ludvig Heiberg laments the sad state of philosophy in Denmark, while lauding German speculative philosophy. Moreover, Kierkegaard's lifelong enemy, the theologian Hans Lassen Martensen claims without exaggeration that the Danish systems of philosophy can be regarded as the "dissecta membra" of earlier German systems. All of the major German idealist philosophers made an impact in Denmark: Kant, Fichte, Schelling, and most significantly, Hegel. Kierkegaard was widely read in the German philosophical literature, which he made use of in countless ways throughout his authorship.

ZU "HEGEL UND DER STAAT" Der erste, der das Leben Hegels schrieb, war der Königsberger Professor Karl Rosenkranz. Sein Buch erschien 1844. Der Verfasser hatte Hegel noch selber gekannt. Unter den persönlichen treuen Schülern ist er einer der freieren; ohne daß er seinen Anschauungen nach gerade der Hegelschen Linken zuzurechnen wäre, ist ihm doch manches mit ihr gemein; nicht bloß eine gewisse Selbständigkeit gegenüber der Systematik des Meisters, sondern mehr noch eine eigentümliche Zersplitterung und Beweglichkeit des Empfindens, ein unruhig stoffsüchtiges Hineingreifen in die Schätze der Zeit und Vergangenheit, ein starker Hang endlich zum geistreichen Widersinn stellen den Verfasser der "Ästhetik des Hässlichen" fast

eher in die Reihe der Strauß, Bauer, Feuerbach als zu den Marheineke, Gabler und Henning. Sein Hegelbuch zeigt von diesen Eigenschaften verhältnismäßig wenig; sie sind da zurückge drängt durch die fromme Achtung des Schillers gegen den toten Meister und wohl auch durch den Ernst des Bewußtseins, sozusagen im amtlichen Auftrag der Schule zu schreiben: die Lebensgeschichte trat an die Öffentlichkeit als Ergänzungsband zu den Werken. Auch die Menge handschriftlichen Stoffes, die das Buch im Abdruck oder Auszug brachte, tat das ihre, dem Verfasser den Raum für seine eigenen Flügel einzunehmen. Immerhin wird der Leser des noch heute unentbehrlichen und von seiner ausgeprägten und zeitcharakteristischen Eigenart willen wohl nie ganz überflüssig zu machenden Buchs noch genug wunderbare Einfälle darin finden.
