This project addresses the problem of teachers lacking adequate resources to teach to the Common Core State Standards (DDSS). Currently, teachers at Sturgis Public Schools (SPS) are required to find and use materials from a variety of resources in order to address the CCSS. The

traditional textbook that is offered to students and teachers at SPS aligns with the Michigan Grade Level Content Expectations (GLCEs), and does not fully align with the CCSS. These teachers spend a lot of time looking for these resources to satisfy the CCSS. This project demonstrates how to implement a Google Site to address the CCSS for Geometry at the fourth grade level. The implementation of the website will be evaluated based on the use of teacher, student, and parent surveys and a common assessment to determine whether the website would be a suitable option to replace a traditional textbook.
