The church provides the branded material and cultural context in which participants' sacred experience of self unfolds. However, this requires participants to "do the work" to properly understand, and ultimately embody, the values associated with the brand. This book raises important questions about the role of branding and music in forming modern sacred identities. As such, it will be of great interest to scholars of Religious Studies, Ethnomusicology and Media Studies.
