Refinement :After prototype trials, the consultant and the users would sit together to discuss what the users required to do, but could not do with the

prototype. The consultant would use this input to refine the prototype and to build new functionality, if needed. Such a configuration manual will be easy to understand as it groups logically related elements together. User manual :This book will serve as a generic user manual.
