The final chapters apply client/server Win32 programming techniques to the specific tasks involved in creating a program, and discuss such critical topics as how to control the behavior of a system at runtime through use of a generic DLL that links at runtime to the appropriate network specific DLL. The disk contains source code from examples and the book's API that can be used as a network-independent intermediary layer between client and server.
