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**Cognitive Development.** In addition to rapid physical growth, young children also exhibit significant development of their cognitive abilities. Stages of Development | Introduction to Psychology

Preoperational thinking occurs between 2 to 7 years and is marked by development of symbolic mental abilities. The sensorimotor stage occurs from birth to 2 years and is when children recognize permanence of objects. During adolescence, individuals establish an ideology and sexual orientation is fixed.

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Child psychologist Jean Piaget documented cognitive changes beginning in adolescence through adulthood 1. He called this period of cognitive development formal operations. During this time, teenagers experience an intellectual growth spurt, where their thinking becomes more abstract and their problem-solving more systematic.

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
