Motor skills are a vital part of healthy

development and are featured prominently both in physical examinations and in parents' baby diaries. It has been known for a long time that motor development is critical for children's understanding of the physical and social world. Learning occurs through dynamic interactions and exchanges with the physical and the social world, and consequently movements of eyes and head, arms and legs, and the entire body are a critical during learning. At birth, we start with relatively poorly developed motor skills but soon gain eye and head control, learn to reach, grasp, sit, and eventually to crawl and walk on our own. Consequently, several theoretical accounts of child development suggest that growth in cognitive, social, and perceptual domains are influenced by infants' own motor experiences.
