Design Pedagogy explains why it is vital for design students that their education helps them construct a 'passport' to enter the professional sphere. This is the essence of 'transformative learning'. This collection explores how design education is, in itself, a passport to practice and showcases how some of the key developments in education use techniques related to collaboration, case studies and experience to motivate students, enable them to express their identity, reflect and learn.
