The Tale of a Fierce Bad Rabbit tells of a bad rabbit which finds a good rabbit sitting on a bench eating a carrot his mother gave him. Wanting the carrot, he takes it from the good rabbit and scratches him to get it. The good rabbit escapes and hides in a nearby hole. Meanwhile, a hunter notices the bad rabbit sitting on the bench and mistakes him for a bird. He fires at the bad rabbit, but on arrival at the spot finds nothing but a carrot and a rabbit tail on the

Helen Beatrix Potter, (1866-1943) is an English author of children's books, who created Peter Rabbit, Jeremy Fisher, Jemima Puddle-Duck, Mrs. Tiggy-Winkle, and other animal characters. In 1902, Frederick Warne & Co. brought her stories and drawings to the public. Norman Warne worked as her editor, but he passed away in 1905, just weeks after he proposed to her. She bought Hill Top Farm in the Lake District that same year. In 1913, Potter married local lawyer William Heelis. She was a successful breeder of sheep and well regarded for her work to protect the beautiful countryside she adored. In her will, she left much of her land holdings to the National Trust to protect it from development and to preserve it for future generations. Young readers are
