has become a reality. History of York Minister Behind the high altar is the Great East Window, the largest expanse of medieval stained glass in the world, which underwent a decade-long restoration and conservation project, completed in 2018. Below the Great East Window currently sits the Orb, a stainless steel dome which opened at the end of October 2012, containing five of the conserved panels from the window, one of which is changed each ...
