The limitation which existing conventions and prejudices place upon woman and the social results of these limitations are described and analyzed. The new view-point of recognizing sex as a fundamental factor in social life, and the development of a scientific theory of the influence of sex from that standpoint, make a suggestive contribution to scientific thought along these lines.
